ZNANSTVENA POSTIGNUĆA

Profesor emeritus Erik Cohen objavio je više od 250 izvornih znanstvenih radova, preglednih članaka i poglavlja u knjigama iz područja socijalne antropologije i sociološke teorije, ali najširi opus njegovih radova upravo je u području turizma, i to u domeni sociologije i antropologije turizma. Veliki broj njegovih radova nedvojbeno se može klasificirati u fundamentalna istraživanja koja su značajno doprinijela razvoju istraživanja u području turizma, ali je svojim interdisciplinarnim pristupom istraživanjima pridonio i ukupnom razvoju društvenih znanosti. Među njegove najcitanije radove ubrajaju se *A Phenomenology of Tourist Experiences*, citiran više od 4.100 puta, i *Towards a Sociology of International Tourism*, citiran više od 4.400 puta. Ukupan broj citata prema Research Gateu veći je od 17.000. S obzirom na to da su brojni njegovi radovi objavljeni u najprestižnijim časopisima u području turizma, ali i u većem broju časopisa iz vrlo različitih znanstvenih disciplina, njihov je odjek i utjecaj na proširenje granica znanja iznimno velik. Na platformi Research.com u području društvenih i humanističkih znanosti profesor Cohen još je uvijek rangiran među 1000 eminentnih znanstvenika u svijetu te zauzima 785. mjesto, odnosno 3. mjesto među vrhunskim znanstvenicima u Izraelu.

Autor je više od 250 znanstvenih publikacija, a svojim radom pridonio je značajnom napretku znanosti u svijetu, ali i u Hrvatskoj.

SAŽETI ŽIVOTOPIS PREDLOŽENIKA

Na temelju članka 21. i članka 76. *Statuta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu*, a u skladu s prijedlogom Sveučilišta u Zagrebu Ekonomskoga fakulteta od 10. veljače 2023., Senat Sveučilišta u Zagrebu na 5. redovitoj sjednici u 354. akademskoj godini (2022./2023.), održanoj 14. veljače 2023., donio je Odluku o pokretanju postupka za dodjelu počasnoga doktorata profesoru emeritusu Eriku Cohenu s Hebrejskoga sveučilišta u Jeruzalemu. Tom je prigodom imenovano i Stručno povjerenstvo za ocjenu prijedloga za dodjelu počasnoga doktorata prof. emer. Eriku Cohenu u sljedećem sastavu:

1. prof. dr. sc. Nevenka Čavlek, Sveučilište u Zagrebu Ekonomski fakultet
2. akademik Gordan Družić, Hrvatska akademija znanosti i umjetnosti
3. prof. dr. sc. Nevena Škrbić Alempijević, Sveučilište u Zagrebu Filozofski fakultet

Nakon što je proučilo prijedlog i razmotrilo obrazloženje o znanstvenom, nastavnom i društvenom doprinosu profesora emeritusa Erika Cohena i sve relevantne elemente, Stručno povjerenstvo podnosi Senatu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu izvješće s mišljenjem i prijedlogom.

Profesor emeritus Erik Cohen rođen je 1932. godine u Zagrebu u sekularnoj židovskoj obitelji. Od 1943. do 1945. pohađao je Dominikansku klasičnu gimnaziju u samostanu u Dubravi, a od 1945. do 1949. godine IV. realnu gimnaziju u Zagrebu. Njegova je obitelj emigrirala iz Zagreba u Izrael 1949. godine pa je eksternu maturu obavio u vojsci u Izraelu 1953. godine. Od 1954. do 1958. studirao je sociologiju i ekonomiju na Hebrejskom sveučilištu, na kojem je 1958. diplomirao, 1962. magistrirao iz područja sociologije i filozofije religije, a disertaciju naslova *The Power Structure of Israeli Development Towns* (na hebrejskom) obranio 1968. godine. Znanstveno se usavršavao 1965. godine na Odjelu za antropologiju Sveučilišta u Manchesteru kod profesora Maxa Gluckmanna. Predavao je na svojem matičnom sveučilištu od 1959. do 2000. godine. U zvanje predavača izabran je 1970. godine, zatim 1972. u zvanje višega predavača, a 1976. izabran je za izvanrednoga profesora te 1982. za redovitoga profesora. Od 1978. do 1982. bio je pročelnik Odjela za sociologiju i antropologiju na Hebrejskom sveučilištu, na kojem je od 1988. do 1992. obnašao dužnost dekana na Fakultetu društvenih znanosti. Bio je gostujući profesor na Sveučilištu u Singapuru, zatim na Fidžiju te na Sveučilištu Bielefeld. Od 2000. godine je Georg S. Wise profesor sociologije (emeritus) na Hebrejskom sveučilištu.

Osim hrvatskoga jezika, aktivno se služi hebrejskim, njemačkim, engleskim, španjolskim i thai jezikom, a pasivno se služi s još nekoliko jezika. Trenutačno živi u Bangkoku u Tajlandu.

ZNANSTVENI DOPRINOS PROFESORA EMERITUSA ERIKA COHENA

Profesor emeritus Erik Cohen veliki je erudit i jedan od najistaknutijih svjetskih znanstvenika u području sociologije i antropologije turizma. Njegova znanstvena istraživanja u tom području nedvojbeno su fundamentalni dio razvoja znanosti, ali i ne samo u tim područjima. Istraživanja je provodio u raznim krajevima svijeta, od Perua i Tajlanda do Pacifičkih otoka i Izraela. Ono po čemu se profesor emeritus Erik Cohen posebno izdvaja svakako je njegov iznimno širok spektar znanstvenoga interesa i ustrajnost na interdisciplinarnim istraživanjima, pri čemu se, među ostalim, bavio istraživanjima kolektivnih naselja, izraelskih kibuca i novih gradova, iseljeničkim imigrantskim zajednicama, međuetničkim ponašanjima, mirom u Izraelu, ovisnošću o drogama, tajlandskom etnografijom, festivalima, religijskim temama, ekološkom etikom. No, najveći su utjecaj njegova istraživanja imala, i još uvijek imaju, u području turizma jer neprekidno pronalazi nove istraživačke teme i koristi se dobro utemeljenim teorijama i metodologijama u društvenim znanostima i aplicira ih u području turizma. Tako je pridonio kreiranju novih znanstvenih spoznaja u tom području. Prvi je u teoriju turizma uveo i razvio *tipologiju turista i turističko iskustvo*, a istraživanja o autentičnosti i homodifikaciji kulture njegovi su „zaštitni znakovi“ u tom području. Tako je njegov članak *A Phenomenology of Tourist Experiences* citiran 4158 puta, a rad *Towards a Sociology of International Tourism* 4437 puta (zaključno s danom pisanja ovoga izvješća). Ukupan broj citata prema Research Gateu veći je od 17.000. Teško bi uopće bilo nabrojiti sva nova područja istraživanja koje je profesor emeritus Erik Cohen otvorio znanstvenicima. Između ostalih, može se izdvojiti egzemplarno istraživanje turizma i međukultурne komunikacije, kulturne raznolikosti i promjene, hrane i kulture, festivala, interpretacija tkanina i materijala itd.

No, profesor emeritus Erik Cohen ne istražuje samo posljedice razvoja nego trasira i smjerove budućega razvoja određene pojave u društvu te tako značajno proširuje granice znanja. Svojim interdisciplinarnim i multidisciplinarnim pristupom istraživanju ulazi u područja koja prije njega nitko nije dotaknuo. Tako ga je u posljednje vrijeme zaokupilo i istraživanje o turizmu u svemiru. Bez obzira na svoje godine, profesor emeritus Erik Cohen još je uvijek vrlo aktivan i plodonosan znanstvenik. Do danas je objavio više od 250 znanstvenih radova, knjiga, poglavljia u knjigama, preglednih članaka iz područja socijalne antropologije i sociološke teorije te posebno širok opus

djela iz područja turizma. Najpoznatije su mu knjige *The Commercialized Crafts of Thailand* (University of Hawai'i Press, 2000), *The Chinese Vegetarian Festival in Phuket* (White Lotus, 2001), *Contemporary Tourism: Diversity and Change* (Elsevier, 2004), *Explorations in Thai Tourism* (Emerald, 2008) i *Space Tourism: The Illusive Dream* (Emerald, 2019).

Redoviti je predavač na programu Ekonomskoga fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu – *International Tourism & Tourism Academy at Sea* (ITHAS), u okviru kojega predaje našim i inozemnim studentima od 2013. godine.

Profesor emeritus Erik Cohen jedan je od osnivača Svjetske turističke akademije i njezin je član od 1988. godine. Supokretač je i najprestižnijega znanstvenoga časopisa iz područja turizma *Annals of Tourism Research*, čiji je urednik za područje sociologije bio od 1970. do kasnih 2000-ih. Uz to, član je uređivačkih odbora mnogih međunarodnih znanstvenih časopisa u području turizma. Istaknuo se i kao vrhunski mentor doktorandima, danas mnogim poznatim svjetskim znanstvenicima u području turizma, koji značajno utječu na smjer kretanja istraživanja u tom području. Recenzirao je na desetke projekata predloženih izraelskim institucijama. Recenzira članke za moguće objavljivanje u najprestižnijim svjetskim časopisima iz područja turizma te je svojim savjetima utjecao i na podizanje rejtinga časopisa *Acta Turistica* Ekonomskoga fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu.

MIŠLJENJE I PRIJEDLOG POVJERENSTVA

Ono što ga izdiže iznad brojnih znanstvenika u pojedinim znanstvenim područjima jest njegova privrženost interdisciplinarnim i multidisciplinarnim istraživanjima i sposobnost premoščivanja jaza između mnogih znanstvenih disciplina od sociologije, ekonomije, etnologije i kulturne antropologije do istraživanja posljedica razvoja turizma na gospodarstvo i društvo u cjelini. Svojim je istraživanjima uvijek bio ispred uvriježenih trendova i standardnih modela mišljenja te je neprestano otvarao, i još uvijek otvara, nova područja od iznimna znanstvenoga interesa. Njegovim je znanstvenim radom obogaćeno široko područje društvenih istraživanja. Profesor emeritus Erik Cohen posebice je pridonio napretku istraživanja u području turizma te je utjecao na brojne znanstvenike u svijetu, ali i u Hrvatskoj. Od 2013. godine surađuje s Ekonomskim fakultetom Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, ponajviše na projektu iskustvenoga učenja u turizmu - *International Tourism & Hospitality Academy at Sea*, čime je iznimno pridonio internacionalizaciji Sveučilišta u Zagrebu i njegovu otvaranju svjetskom prostoru visokoga obrazovanja. Prilikom svakoga radnoga posjeta Hrvatskoj održao je i predavanja studentima na Ekonomskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu na prijediplomskoj, diplomskoj i poslijediplomskoj razini, nesebično dijeleći svoja znanja studentima i mladim znanstvenicima.

Na temelju navedenoga obrazloženja povjerenstvo je suglasno u ocjeni da profesor emeritus Erik Cohen ispunjava sve uvjete za dodjelu počasnoga doktorata Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, u skladu sa *Statutom Sveučilišta u Zagrebu*. Poštovani profesore Cohen,
poštovani rektore Sveučilišta u Zagrebu,
poštovani uzvanici i gosti, dragi kolege!

Osjećam se zaista počašćeno i sretno što mogu u svojstvu promotorice na dodjeli počasnoga doktorata Sveučilišta u Zagrebu predstaviti današnjega laureata, profesora emeritusa Erika Cohena s Hebrejskoga sveučilišta u Jeruzalemu.

Senat Sveučilišta u Zagrebu na svojoj je 6. sjednici u 354. akademskoj godini (2022./2023.) održanoj 21. ožujka 2023., na rektorov prijedlog, a na temelju izvješća stručnog povjerenstva u sastavu: prof. dr. sc. Nevenka Čavlek, akademik Gordan Družić i prof. dr. sc. Nevenka Škrbić Alempijević, donio odluku o dodjeli počasnoga doktorata Sveučilišta u Zagrebu profesoru emeritusu Eriku Cohenu za njegov doprinos u području sociologije i antropologije turizma te za uspješnu suradnju na internacionalizaciji Sveučilišta u Zagrebu.

Profesor emeritus Erik Cohen rođen je u Zagrebu, gdje je pohađao Dominikansku klasičnu gimnaziju u samostanu u Dubravi te nakon rata IV. realnu gimnaziju. Njegova obitelj emigrirala je u Izrael 1949. godine pa je eksternu maturu završio u vojsci u Izraelu. Sva svoja akademска zvanja stekao je na Hebrejskom sveučilištu u Jeruzalemu. Diplomirao je sociologiju i ekonomiju 1958. godine, magistrirao iz područja sociologije i filozofije religije 1962. godine, a doktorsku disertaciju obranio je 1968. godine iz područja sociologije. Predavao je na svom matičnom sveučilištu od 1959., najprije u zvanju predavača, pa višega predavača, a 1976. godine izabran je za izvanrednoga profesora te šest godina poslije u zvanje redovitoga profesora. Na tom je sveučilištu obnašao i dužnost pročelnika Odjela za sociologiju

i antropologiju, a od 1988. do 1992. dužnost dekana Fakulteta društvenih znanosti. Bio je gostujući profesor na Sveučilištu u Singapuru, zatim na Fidžiju te na Sveučilištu Bielefeld. Hebrejsko sveučilište dodijelilo mu je 2000. godine titulu Georg S. Wise profesor sociologije (emeritus).

Profesor emeritus Erik Cohen ubraja se u elitnu skupinu najpoznatijih i najpriznatijih znanstvenika u području sociologije i antropologije turizma u svijetu. Njegovi su istraživački interesi oduvijek bili iznimno široki. Bavio se istraživanjima kolektivnih naselja, izraelskih kibuca i novih gradova, iseljeničkim zajednicama, međuetničkim ponašanjima, mirom u Izraelu, ovisnošću o drogama, tajlandskom etnografijom, festivalima, religijskim temama, ekološkom etikom. Ipak, svoj je najveći doprinos znanosti dao u području turizma. Gotovo da ne postoji tema u turizmu koju on nije prvi počeo istraživati i time trasirati istraživački put ostalim znanstvenicima. Prvi je u teoriju turizma uveo i razvio *tipologiju turista i turističko iskustvo*, a istraživanja o autentičnosti i komodifikaciji kulture njegovi su „zaštitni znakovi“. Čuveno je njegovo egzemplarno istraživanje turizma i međukulturalne komunikacije, zatim kulturnih raznolikosti i promjena, hrane i kulture, festivala, interpretacija tkanina i materijala, biljaka i turizma, turističke umjetnosti itd. Svojim je istraživanjima uvijek bio ispred uvriježenih trendova i standardnih modela mišljenja te je neprestano otvarao, i još uvijek otvara, nova područja od iznimna znanstvenoga interesa. Time je izuzetno doprinio napretku istraživanja, i to ne samo u području turizma.

Svojim interdisciplinarnim i multidisciplinarnim pristupom istraživanju te lakoća s kojom premošće jaz između mnogih znanstvenih disciplina, od sociologije, ekonomije, etnologije i kulturne antropologije do političkih znanosti korištenjem utemeljenih teorija i metodologija, omogućile su mu neprijeporan status znanstvenika koji je postao sinonim za sociologiju turizma u svijetu. Njegovi radovi fasciniraju prožetošću turizma unutar različitih znanstvenih disciplina. Time je dao nemjerljiv doprinos proširenju granica znanstvenih spoznaja u bogatom spektru društvenih znanosti.

Jedan je od osnivača Svjetske turističke akademije (International Academy for the Study of Tourism) i njezin je član od 1988. godine. Bio je i supokretač jednoga od najprestižnijih znanstvenih časopisa iz područja turizma *Annals*

of Tourism Research te njegov urednik za područje sociologije. Uz to je član uređivačkih odbora brojnih znanstvenih časopisa te isto tako i iznimno cijenjen recenzent.

Doprinos profesora emeritusa Erika Cohena znanosti i obrazovnom procesu u području turizma prepoznaла je i Svjetska turistička organizacija koja mu je 2012. godine dodijelila najprestižniju nagradu - *Ulysses Award* - mogli bismo slobodno reći pandan Nobelove nagrade, za doprinos znanosti te za izvrsnost u kreiranju i diseminaciji znanja u području turizma.

S ponosom želim istaknuti i činjenicu da profesor emeritus Erik Cohen ima vrlo razvijenu znanstvenu suradnju s Ekonomskim fakultetom Sveučilišta u Zagrebu i da od 2013. godine redovito drži predavanja našim i međunarodnim studentima na intenzivnom modulu edukacije u području turizma pod nazivom *International Tourism & Hospitality Academy at Sea (ITHAS)*, čime kontinuirano pridonosi internacionalizaciji Sveučilišta u Zagrebu i njegovu širem otvaranju svjetskom prostoru visokoga obrazovanja. Svojim je savjetima utjecao i na podizanje rejtinga najstarijega časopisa u izdanju Ekonomskoga fakulteta - časopisa *Acta Turistica*, u kojem je objavio i svoja dva znanstvena rada.

Ovaj smo trenutak svi s velikom radošću iščekivali jer će ta dodjela počasnog doktorata značiti da je profesor emeritus Erik Cohen, čiji temelji znanstvene radoznalosti potječe upravo iz Zagreba, zaokružio svoje akademsko životno postignuće na čast i ponos svojoj dosad neostvarenoj *Alma Mater* – Sveučilištu u Zagrebu, ali i na čast i ponos svojem vjernom Hebrejskom sveučilištu u Jeruzalemu.

HRVATSKI

Godine 1949., kada se moj otac, nakon što je sve izgubio za vrijeme NDH i ostao nezadovoljan komunističkim režimom, odlučio iseliti s obitelji u Izrael, ni u snu nisam mogao zamisliti da će za gotovo tri četvrt stoljeća stajati ovdje pred vama, primajući počasni doktorat. Meni je to velika čast i zahvaljujem Sveučilištu u Zagrebu na tome.

Moj povratak u Zagreb bio je dugačak. Nakon dolaska u Izrael, prionuo sam na studij na Hebrejskom sveučilištu u Jeruzalemu, doktorirao, ostao ondje kao nastavnik oko 40 godina te sam danas profesor emeritus toga sveučilišta. Na turizam kao sociološku temu došao sam slučajno. Naime, 1966. godine, nakon boravka na Antropološkom odjelu Sveučilišta u Manchesteru, započeo sam antropološko istraživanje o odnosu Židova i Arapa u starom gradu Akkou. Tijekom toga istraživanja uočio sam kako su mladi Arapi pridavali važnost odnosa s mlađim turistkinjama iz Skandinavije te sam o tome objavio znanstveni članak. Nakon nekoliko godina počeo sam razmišljati o društvenoj ulozi turizma i objavljivati teorijske članke o toj temi. Nakon posjeta plemenima u tajlandskim brdima 1973. godine, počeo sam niz istraživanja o turizmu, plemenima i njihovoj umjetnosti, što je malo po malo

dovelo do porasta zanimanja za tajlandsко društvo i turizam. Nakon odlasku u mirovinu i nakon smrti moje supruge, odlučio sam živjeti u Tajlandu, gdje sam se ponovno i oženio. Tijekom svih tih godina izgubio sam vezu sa Zagrebom i nisam ga posjetio 64 godine, dok me 2013. godine profesorica Nevenka Čavlek nije pozvala u Zadar na znanstvenu konferenciju *Myths of Tourism* i na sudjelovanje u edukacijskom programu Ekonomskoga fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu - *International Tourism & Hospitality Academy at Sea - ITHAS*. Time se stvorila nova veza s Hrvatskom i Zagrebom, koja je ojačala tijekom godina znanstvene suradnje i brojnih posjeta mojem rodnom gradu te konačno dovela na ovu svečanost.

Htio bih zahvaliti Sveučilištu u Zagrebu, gospodinu rektoru, prof. dr. sc. Stjepanu Lakušiću, gospodri dekanici Ekonomskoga fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, prof. dr. sc. Sanji Sever Mališ, Povjerenstvu za dodjelu počasnoga doktorata te Senatu Sveučilišta, koji je prihvatio tu odluku.

Hvala vam mnogo na ovoj velikoj počasti.

Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen has published more than 250 original scientific papers, review articles, and book chapters in social anthropology and sociological theory, but the majority of his work has been in the field of tourism, specifically, in the sociology and anthropology of tourism. He is the author of several seminal publications that have significantly advanced tourism studies, and his interdisciplinary research approach has contributed to the overall development of social sciences. His most cited works include *A Phenomenology of Tourist Experiences* with more than 4,100 citations, and *Towards a Sociology of International Tourism* with more than 4,400 citations. According to *Research Gate*, Professor Cohen has been cited in more than 17,000 publications in total. Having been published in the most prestigious journals in the field of tourism, and a number of journals in other scientific disciplines, his papers have had exceptional resonance and impact in extending the boundaries of knowledge. Professor Cohen ranks as the 785th of the world's 1000 most eminent scientists in the field of social sciences and humanities according to Research.com and 3rd among top scientists in Israel.

THE NOMINEE'S SHORT CURRICULUM VITAE

Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen was born in 1932 in Zagreb to a secular Jewish family. From 1943 to 1945, he attended the Dominican High School in a monastery in Dubrava, and from 1945 to 1949 he attended the IV. High School in Zagreb. His family emigrated from Zagreb to Israel in 1949, so he graduated externally while in the army in Israel in 1953. From 1954 to 1958 he studied sociology and economics at the Hebrew University, where he graduated in 1958. He obtained his master's degree in sociology and philosophy of religion from the same university in 1962. He defended his doctoral dissertation *The Power Structure of Israeli Development Towns* (in Hebrew) in 1968 at the Hebrew University. He underwent research training at the Department of Anthropology at the University of Manchester in 1965 under Professor Max Gluckman. He taught at his alma mater from 1959 to 2000. He was promoted to lecturer in 1970, senior lecturer in 1972, associate professor in 1976, and full-tenured professor in 1982. From 1978 to 1982 he served as the Head of the Department of Sociology and Anthropology at the Hebrew University. He served as the Dean of the Hebrew University's Faculty of Social Sciences from 1988 to 1992. He was a visiting professor at the University of Singapore, the University of Fiji, and Bielefeld University. Since 2000, he has been a Georg S. Wise professor of sociology (emeritus) at the same university. In addition to the Croatian language, he is proficient in Hebrew, German, English, Spanish, and Thai and is familiar with several other languages. He currently lives in Bangkok, Thailand.

PROFESSOR ERIK COHEN'S SCIENTIFIC CONTRIBUTION

Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen is a great erudite and one of the world's most prominent scientists in the field of sociology and anthropology of tourism. His scientific research has undoubtedly been fundamental to the development of science not only in this field but in other fields as well. He has conducted research in various parts of the world, from Peru and Thailand to the Pacific Islands and Israel. What makes Professor Erik Cohen stand out is an extremely wide range of academic interests and dedication to interdisciplinary research, including research into collective settlements, Israeli kibbutz and new cities, immigrant communities, interethnic behaviours, peace in Israel, drug addiction, ethnography of Thailand, festivals, religious topics, environmental ethics. Yet his research has had the greatest impact within the field of tourism where he continuously finds new research topics and applies the well-founded theories and methodologies of social sciences in tourism studies, thus contributing to the creation of new scientific knowledge in this field. He was the first to introduce and develop *the typology of tourists* and *tourist experience* in tourism studies. Research on *authenticity* and *commodification of culture* is his trademark in the field. His article *A Phenomenology of Tourist Experiences* has been cited 4,158 times, and his paper *Towards a Sociology of International Tourism* 4,437 times (as of the time of writing this report). According to *Research Gate*, Professor Cohen has been cited in more than 17,000 publications in total. It would be difficult to list all the new areas of research that Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen has opened up for scientists. To mention a few, we can highlight exemplary exploration of tourism and intercultural communication, cultural diversity and change, food and culture, festivals, interpretations of fabrics and materials, etc. But Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen not only explores the consequences of development but also maps the future development of a particular phenomenon in society and thus significantly expands the boundaries of knowledge. With his interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary approach to research, he is a pioneer in areas that no one has considered before. In recent years, he has also engaged in research into space tourism. Despite his age, Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen is still a very active and prolific scientist. To date, he has published more than 250 scientific papers, books, book chapters, and review articles in social anthropology and sociological theory and a particularly rich opus of works in tourism. His most famous books are *The*

Commercialised Crafts of Thailand (University of Hawai'i Press, 2000), *The Chinese Vegetarian Festival in Phuket* (White Lotus, 2001), *Contemporary Tourism: Diversity and Change* (Elsevier, 2004), *Explorations in Thai Tourism* (Emerald, 2008) and *Space Tourism: The Illusive Dream* (Emerald, 2019).

Professor Cohen ranks as the 785th of the world's 1000 most eminent scientists in the field of social sciences and humanities according to Research.com and 3rd among top scientists in Israel.

CONTRIBUTION TO THE COMMUNITY

The research of Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen has numerous applications in tourism, economics, ethnology and cultural anthropology, marketing, management, and political sciences. He has participated in many international conferences, and in 2013, he returned to Croatia for the first time after emigration to attend the Myths of Tourism conference organised by the Faculty of Economics & Business of the University of Zagreb and the University of Zadar. He has held numerous lectures at the world's most prestigious universities. As a regular lecturer at the education program of the Faculty of Economics, University of Zagreb titled *International Tourism & Tourism Academy at Sea* (ITHAS), he has taught domestic and foreign students since 2013.

Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen has been one of the founders of the International Academy for the Study of Tourism and its member since 1988. He is also a co-founder of the most prestigious scientific journal in the field of tourism, *Annals of Tourism Research*. He was the Sociology Editor for the journal from the 1970s to the late 2000s. He sits on the editorial boards of many international academic journals in the field of tourism. Furthermore, he has distinguished himself as an excellent mentor to doctoral students, many of whom have become well-known scientists in the field of tourism and have significantly influenced the direction of research in this field. He has reviewed dozens of projects proposed to Israeli institutions. He serves as a reviewer for the most prestigious magazines on tourism and his advice has improved the rating of the journal *Acta Turistica* of the Faculty of Economics & Business, University of Zagreb.

AWARDS AND HONOURS

In 2012, Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen received the greatest recognition for his rich and long-standing scientific and educational work in the field of tourism when the United Nations World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO) in Madrid awarded him the prestigious Ulysses Prize for Excellence in the Creation and Dissemination of Knowledge.

As the promotor at the Honorary Doctorate of the University of Zagreb award ceremony, I feel truly honoured and delighted to be able to present today's laureate, Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.

Following the Rector's proposal and the recommendation of the Honorary Doctorate Committee composed of Professor Nevenka Čavlek, academician Gordan Družić, and Professor Nevena Škrbić Alempijević, at its 6th regular session in the 354th academic year (2022/2023) held on 21 March 2023, the Senate of the University of Zagreb passed the decision to award an honorary doctorate from the University of Zagreb to Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen for his contribution in the field of sociology and anthropology of tourism and for successful cooperation on the internationalisation of the University of Zagreb.

Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen was born in Zagreb where he attended the Dominican Classical Gymnasium in the monastery in Dubrava and the IV. Realgymnasium after the war. However, he has made his greatest contribution to science in the field of tourism. There is almost no topic in tourism research that he was not the first to research thus paving the way for other scientists. He was the first to introduce and develop the typology of tourists and tourist experience in the theory of tourism, and his research on *authenticity* and *commodification of culture* is his trademark. He is well-known for his exemplary exploration of tourism and intercultural communication, cultural diversity and change, food and culture, festivals, interpretations of fabrics and materials, plants and tourism, tourist art, etc. His research has always been ahead of the established trends and standard models of thinking constantly opening up new areas of exceptional scientific interest. He has greatly contributed to the advancement of research not only in the field of tourism.

His interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary approach to research and the ease with which he bridges the gap between many disciplines, from sociology, economics, ethnology, and cultural anthropology to political sciences by applying well-founded theories and methodologies, have secured his indisputable reputation as a scientist who has become synonymous with the sociology of tourism in the world. He has made an immeasurable contribution to extending the boundaries of scientific knowledge in the rich spectrum of social sciences through publications that fascinate by revealing the pervasiveness of tourism within different scientific disciplines.

He is one of the founders of the International Academy for the Study of Tourism and its member since 1988. He was also the co-founder of one of the most prestigious scientific journals in the field of tourism, *Annals of Tourism Research*, and its Sociology Editor. He is a member of the editorial boards of numerous academic journals and serves as a highly respected reviewer.

The contribution of Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen to science and education in the field of tourism was recognised in 2012 by the United Nations World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO), which awarded him the prestigious Ulysses Prize — we could freely call the counterpart of the Nobel Prize, for the contribution to science and excellence in the creation and dissemination of knowledge in the field of tourism.

I am proud to highlight the well-established cooperation between Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen and the Faculty of Economics & Business, University of Zagreb. Since 2013 Professor Cohen has held lectures for domestic and international students of an intensive study module in the field of tourism titled International Tourism & Hospitality Academy at Sea (ITHAS), continuously contributing to the internationalisation of the University of Zagreb and its positioning on the world map of higher education. Address by Professor Emeritus Erik Cohen

ENGLISH

In 1949, when my father, having lost everything during the NDH (Independent State of Croatia) and remained dissatisfied with the communist regime, decided to emigrate with his family to Israel, I could not have imagined standing here almost three-quarters of a century later being awarded an honorary doctorate. I would like to thank the University of Zagreb for this wonderful honour.

My return journey to Zagreb was a long one. Upon arriving in Israel, I applied myself to my studies at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, where I received my doctorate and stayed as a teacher for about 40 years. Today, I am a Professor Emeritus at the same university. I started exploring tourism as a sociological topic by accident. In 1966, following my visit to the Department of Anthropology of the University of Manchester, I began an anthropological study on the relationship between Jews and Arabs in the old city of Akko. During this research, I noticed how young Arabs gave special attention to their relationships with young female tourists from Scandinavia and I published a scientific article about it. A few years later, I began considering the social role of tourism and publishing theoretical articles on the subject. A visit to the mountain tribes of Thailand in 1973 initiated a series of research

on tourism, tribes, and their arts, which gradually led to an increased interest in Thai society and tourism. After my retirement and my wife's death, I decided to move to Thailand where I remarried. During all these years, I lost my connection to Zagreb and did not visit for 64 years until 2013, when Professor Nevenka Čavlek invited me to join the conference *Myths of Tourism* in Zadar and the educational program of the Faculty of Economics & Business of the University of Zagreb — *International Tourism & Hospitality Academy at Sea* — ITHAS. This has built a new connection with Croatia and Zagreb, which has strengthened over the years of scientific cooperation and numerous visits to my hometown and eventually brought me to this ceremony.

I would like to thank the University of Zagreb, the Rector, Professor Stjepan Lakušić, Dean of the Faculty of Economics & Business in Zagreb, Professor Sanja Sever Mališ, the Honorary Doctorate Committee, and the Senate of the University who have supported the decision.

Thank you so much for this great honour.
